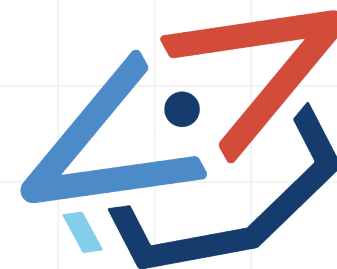

TN Promise is a last-dollar scholarship for graduating high school seniors that covers full tuition at community and technical colleges. Some four-year colleges offering associate degrees are also eligible, but funding may be different.

- 1 APPLY**
Apply online at tnpromise.gov by November 1
- 2 FAFSA**
Submit your 2024-25 FAFSA at studentaid.gov by April 15
- 3 MEET**
Attend your mandatory meeting*
- 4 VOLUNTEER**
Complete 8 hours of service between November 2 - July 1*

*The partnering organization is assigned based on the TN county in which the applicant resides. They will notify applicants of mandatory meeting dates and community service opportunities. They will collect attendance and service hours and report to THEC/TSAC for eligibility purposes.

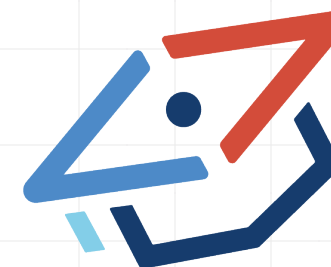
