# THERE'S MONEY FOR YOU TO GO TO COLLEGE



TN Promise is a last-dollar scholarship for graduating high school seniors that covers full tuition at community and technical colleges. Some four-year colleges offering associate degrees are also eligible, but funding may be different.

- 1 APPLY**  
Apply online at [tnpromise.gov](https://tnpromise.gov) by **NOVEMBER 2, 2026**
- 2 FAFSA**  
Submit your 2027-28 FAFSA at [studentaid.gov](https://studentaid.gov) by **APRIL 1, 2027**
- 3 MEET**  
Attend your mandatory meeting\*
- 4 VOLUNTEER**  
Complete at least 16 hours of service by **AUGUST 2, 2027**

\*The partnering organization is assigned based on the TN county in which the applicant resides. They will notify applicants of mandatory meeting dates and community service opportunities. They will collect attendance and service hours and report to THEC for eligibility purposes.
